3. The names and email addresses of no fewer than 2 and no more than 5 media outlets you wish to receive press releases from us, should you win The American Prize, such as local newspapers, radio or television stations, alumni newsletters, etc. We encourage you to CONFIRM these emails first, as we cannot research incomplete or inaccurate email addresses.
