FINAL DEADLINE for Chicago Oratorio Applications is May 1, 2019

PERFORM Beethoven's *Symphony No. 9* with the Chicago Bar Association Symphony Orchestra and CBA Chorus, the DePaul Community Chorus and Niles Metropolitan Chorus (more than 300 musicians in all) under the baton of music director Maestro David Katz in June 2019, including at Orchestra Hall/Symphony Center (home of the Chicago Symphony.)

OVERVIEW:

For the eighth consecutive year, in addition to the national voice competitions outlined on **The American Prize** website and on page 1 of this application, contestants for **The American Prize in Vocal Performance**, **2019**, may also apply for The American Prize **Chicago Oratorio Award**, four \$1500 prizes: one each for soprano, mezzo-soprano (alto), tenor, baritone (bass), to be awarded as performance fees to soloists selected to appear under Maestro David Katz's baton in concert with the Chicago Bar Association Symphony Orchestra & Chorus and guest choirs, this season performing Beethoven's *Symphony No. 9* (in German).

WHO is ELIGIBLE:

Soprano, mezzo-soprano (alto), tenor and baritone (bass) applicants for **The American Prize in Vocal Performance**, **2019**, in the *professional* & *college/university* categories, only. Be sure to apply by the final deadline date for The American Prize competitions.

WHAT is the PRIZE:

Winners will be featured as vocal soloists in Beethoven's *Symphony No.* 9 under the baton of Maestro David Katz, with the Chicago Bar Association Symphony Orchestra and CBA Chorus and guest choirs in Niles (IL) and at Orchestra Hall / Chicago. Each winner will receive a \$1500 all-inclusive fee (no additional housing, travel or per diem), payment to be made on the day of the second performance. Video recordings of the Chicago concert will be available to winners, at cost.

Although the **Chicago Oratorio Award** is an additional contest open to all professional and college/university applicants for **The American Prize in Vocal Performance**, **2019**, it is geared primarily to those who live within comfortable travel distance of Chicago and who can make their own housing arrangements.

Piano rehearsal: Friday, May 31, 2019, 5 pm (St John Brebeuf Church, Niles, IL) Dress rehearsal with orchestra: Friday, May 31, 2019, 7—10 pm (same location)

PERFORMANCE: Sunday, June 2, 2019, 3:00 pm (same location)

Dress rehearsal with orchestra: Thursday, June 20, 2019, 7—10 pm (Orchestra Hall / Symphony Center, Chicago)

PERFORMANCE: Saturday, June 22, 2019, 8 pm (Orchestra Hall / Symphony Center, Chicago)

HOW to APPLY:

- 1. Check the box marked "Chicago Oratorio Award" on the first page of this application.
- 2. In addition to submitting all the materials required for **The American Prize** competition (listed on page 1 of this application), send a copy of your resume, plus other supporting documents (reviews, letters of recommendation.) Send this information either as attachments or as hard copies to The American Prize office. If you have performed the Beethoven before, be sure to note that in your materials and supply a link (if available) to an audio or video of that performance.
- 3. On page 3, write the names of **three references** we can contact who can comment about your skill and experience as a performer. Include with your application. They may be teachers, conductors, directors or coaches. Include telephone and email.
- 4. There is no additional application fee for the **Chicago Oratorio Award** beyond the \$45 fee to apply for **The American Prize in Vocal Performance**.
- 5. The selection process for the **Chicago Oratorio Award** is separate from **The American Prize** judging. Winning one competition does not preclude the possibility of winning the other. The four singers selected to perform will be announced on **The American Prize** website and to the media as winners of the **Chicago Oratorio Award**, but will not receive additional written evaluations or certificates

The American Prize CHICAGO ORATORIO AWARD, more

beyond those they may receive as contestants for The American Prize.

6. You are encouraged to **APPLY EARLY**. Maestro Katz expects to select the winners of the **Chicago Oratorio Award** within days of May 1st postmark deadline. The decisions of the judges are final.
