- A photograph of the pianist (JPEG or PGN only). Be sure the file name *includes applicant's name*.
- The name and email addresses of no fewer than 2 and no more than 5 media outlets you wish to receive press releases from us, should the applicant win The American Prize, such as local newspapers, radio or television stations, alumni newsletters, etc. Please CONFIRM these emails first, as we cannot research incomplete or inaccurate email addresses.
