Email: Be sure to identify yourself in the subject line of a *single* email which contains:

1. A 75 word (maximum) biography of yourself sent in the body of an email, not as an attachment. Resumes are not accepted.
2. A photograph of yourself (JPEG only). Be sure the file name includes your name.
3. The name and email addresses of no fewer than 2 and no more than 5 media outlets you wish to receive press releases from us, should you win The American Prize, such as local newspapers, radio or television stations, alumni newsletters, etc. We encourage you to CONFIRM these emails first, as we cannot research incomplete or inaccurate email addresses.
